NOTE: There will be no printed catalogues. All exhibitors will receive an email prior to the hunt test that the Catalogue and Running Order has been posted on dogshow.ca.

Entries will be accepted until the time of the **Draw at 7 pm on Tuesday, May 14, 2024.** The draw for running order will be held at the home of the Hunt Test secretary after time of closing. The running order may be changed on the day of the tests as provided by the Official Rules.

Entry Fees will not be refunded after May 14, 2024. In the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee or the Canadian Kennel Club, or because it has been entered incorrectly, or if it is impossible to open or complete the test, no refund of entry will be made.

Full refunds (excluding dogshow.ca service charge) will be given for dogs withdrawn because of an injury, illness or death, and for bitches in season, if notification in writing is accompanied by a veterinarian's certificate. Refunds will be given for other legitimate reasons, subject to approval by the Hunt Test Committee.

A \$10.50 (plus GST) Temporary Competition Number (TCN) is required for dogs not registered with the CKC. CKC registration or ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the test or all awards will be cancelled. The special application forms are available from the CKC at the above address or online at <u>www.ckc.ca</u>.

Please note: The CKC ruling: Canadian Resident non-CKC members running a wholly owned dog cannot win a placement unless they pay a non-member participation fee or a membership fee to the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

Rosettes and duck bands will be awarded for all qualifying dogs and will be presented at the end of each teston Friday and Sunday. On Saturday they will be awarded at the Barbecue.

Ducks will be used in all stakes. Pheasants may be used in the Master stake. Handlers should be dressed in hunting attire, dark or camouflage clothing, orange for the upland test.

Bitches in season are not eligible for entry and are not allowed on the test grounds.

Vehicles must be confined to designated roads and parking areas only. Please take any recycling or refuse with you.

RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION:

By participating in these tests (as handler, spectator or in any other role) each participant agrees to assume all risk and hazards incidental to these tests and agrees to release and to save harmless and indemnify the Kamloops Gun Dog Club and its members, any volunteer and the owners of the property upon which the tests are held together with their officers, agents, employees and representatives from all claims, actions, cost expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to the person or property of the participant howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the participants, his or her heirs, executors and assigns.
