



- 1. To increase awareness and appreciation of dogs as valued, contributing members of society.
- 2. To assist in teaching and promoting responsible dog ownership.3
- 3. To certify that dogs conduct themselves in a manner which is reliable and trustworthy in situations encountered in everyday living, be it around people, at home, in public, or in the presence of other dogs.

- I agree and acknowledge that I have met all the prerequisites required for participation in this Event by the CKC and the CKOC and will abide by its rules and regulations, this includes, but is not limited to personal conduct toward fellow exhibitors, the Calgary Kennel and Obedience Club, its executive members, club members, volunteers and paid employees.
- 2. As a participant, I acknowledge and understand that I may suffer property damage or loss, personal injury and even death. This also includes, but is not limited to the novel coronavirus, COVID-19 and all its variants. I freely and voluntarily assume all the risks and hazards of participation, including any legal risks. I am giving up my right to sue the Calgary Kennel and Obedience Club, its executive members, club members, volunteers and paid employees for any reason, whatsoever.
- 3. I agree and acknowledge that, I waive any claim I may have against the Calgary Kennel and Obedience Club, its executive members, club members, volunteers and paid employees, arising from my participation in this Event, however it is caused, and I agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Calgary Kennel and Obedience Club, its executive members, club members, volunteers and paid employees from all claims arising from my participation in this Event.
- 4. This RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK and INDEMNITY is binding for myself, my heirs, my executors, administrators, personal representatives and assignees.

WARNING: THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY <u>ZERO</u> TOLERANCE FOR DOGS LEFT IN VEHICLES WHEN WARM WEATHER CONDITIONS CAUSE DISTRESS.

THE RCMP WILL BE CALLED AND VEHICLE WINDOWS WILL BE BROKEN. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR DOG(S)' HEALTH AND SAFETY. PLAN ACCORDINGLY.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Competing*	2	3 – 5	6 – 9	10 – 12	13 or more

* includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall <u>NOT</u> be included in the calculation for points. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF BREED at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF OPPOSITE SEX to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing for Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS is also awarded BEST OF WINNERS, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded WINNERS only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per Section 15.1.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded WINNERS, which also places in the regular Group competition, shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

A dog awarded WINNERS which also places BEST IN SHOW at an All-Breed Championship Show shall be credited with 5 Championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In no case can a dog earn more then five points at a single show.

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour BEFORE the start of the show.

Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

Things to Note....

- 1. The CKOC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be held responsible for, or assume any liability, in the event of an accident or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 2. Showing correct information on entry forms and any other necessary forms, eg. Move-up forms, is the responsibility of the entrant. The CKOC or the Show Secretary will not correct/complete any incorrect or incomplete entries/forms.
- 3. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$15.00 per copy including GST.
- 4. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 5. Entries will be acknowledged after entry by DogShow.ca and a judging schedule will be available after the closing date. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
- 6. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 7. REFUND POLICY COVID-19: If we are required to CANCEL the show due to any Alberta Government, City of Olds or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies, or directives, a partial refund (based upon our unrecoverable costs) of entries will be reimbursed. In the event of any refunds, credit card and Dogshow.ca charges will not be refunded.
- 8. ENTRY FEES WILL ONLY BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE OR RALLY COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- 9. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS.
- 10. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs one hour prior to the show as well as during the shows.
- 11. SHOW PRECINCTS shall be restricted to the entire Olds Regional Exhibitions Grounds
- 12. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- 13. NO PINCH COLLARS ALLOWED ANYWHERE ON THE REGIONAL EXHIBITION GROUNDS. Exhibitors using Pinch/Prong collars will be excused from the shows/trials for the remainder of the weekend.
- 14. Group judging will follow breed judging through to BIS whenever possible. No two groups will be judged simultaneously. Should a conflict arise, the Chief Ring Steward shall determine which Group will be judged first.
- 15. The entire show site is designated "NO SMOKING/VAPING" Exhibitors are not to be smoking/vaping near or about entrances/exits.
- 16. All exhibitors are to physically show their dog's bites to the judge in the ring. Thank you for helping to prevent the spread of disease.
- 17. Any show official, volunteer, employee or exhibitor shall not be subjected to any indignity by anyone at these shows. Should this occur, the offender may be excused from the show/building by the Show Superintendent or his/her representative.
- 18. Unsportsmanlike conduct (e.g. loud, abusive, profanity ringside, etc.) will not be tolerated and could result in expulsion from the show. Please demonstrate sportsmanlike behavior while on the show grounds as a good example to other exhibitors and to spectators.
