Judging on Friday will begin at 1:00 pm. Whenever possible group judging will follow breed judging through Best in Show..No two groups will be judged at the same time and in the event of a conflict with groups the show committee will decide which group will be judged first.

The successful transmission of a fax entry is not a guarantee that it has been received by the show secretary. Please confirm fax entries by calling 306-352-4094 or email linda10@dogshow.ca. (it is not necessary to do both - your email or call will be returned). Fax entries processed through dogshow.ca in Regina.

Tendering an NSF cheque or any invalid or declined credit card shall be considered non-payment of entry fee and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by CKC. A collection fee of \$20.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheques or invalid or declined cards.

### Questions Regarding your Entries

If you leave out any credit card information your entries will not be processed. We require the complete number, name of card holder, type of card and expiry date for all cards processed. Credit card entries will be processed through dogshow.ca in Regina. Please print clearly and provide correct information. If your card doesn't go through a service charge will be added to your entry fee.

To comply with CKC rules we are not able to accept, alter, cancel or substitute any entry reaching the show secretary after the closing date. Entries will be acknowledged after closing date. Receipts and judging schedules will be mailed. Armbands can be picked up at the Show Secretary's table.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). Simply mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with a cheque, money order or Visa/Mastercard number in the amount of \$58.85 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. This ERN must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. #### Information and Regulations

Important notice: Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs, both inside and outside the show building. Exercise pens will be set up outside the building and in the benching area. The Show Superintendent reserves the right to eject from the show anyone who does not clean up after their dog. Exercising of dogs on the adjacent grasses of the community hall is strictly prohibited. This rule will be enforced. Dogs may be walked in the field to the south of the show building - take clean up supplies with you. The town of Battleford has a by-law that states all dogs must be leashed. Show precincts are the Battleford Arena.

The Chautauqua Canine Club will not be held responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune, to dogs, exhibitors, or patrons. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other act beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show no refund of entry will be made. All dogs must be kept under complete control at all times. No dogs will be allowed in the show building unless entered in the show or obedience trial.

Obedience entry fees will be refunded if a bitch comes into season after entries have closed and must be withdrawn. The bitch must be available for inspection by the Show Superintendent or a dated Veterinarian's certificate must be produced prior to the trial.

The building will be open on Thursday from 7:00 pm to 10:00 pm only for exhibitors to set up. The building will be open on Friday and Saturday from 7:00 am to 11:00 pm and on Sunday from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm. No night watchman will be on duty. Dogs left in the building at your own risk.

#### Classes

Junior Puppy Class. Dogs 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on day of show. Senior Puppy Class. Dogs 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on day of show. 12 to 18 mo.

Canadian Bred Class. Dogs born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded. Bred by Exhibitor Class. Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner and breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

Open Class. All dogs may be divided by colour if permission of the CKC is obtained.

Specials Only. Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration Number and have attained the required points for Championship status. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

Obedience classes offered: Novice A&B, Open A&B and Utility only. (No transition classes offered)

Rally Classes offered: Novice A&B, Advanced A&B, Excellent A&B.

**Champions and Championship Points**

A dog awarded winners at a Championship show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded winners shall be provided hereunder.

The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded winners shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\*includes the dog awarded winners.

The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded winners shall be determined by the highest award (Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex and/or Best of Breed) earned and calculated as per section . In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level. Following is the schedule for breeds competing at group level:

A dog may not be credited with more than 5 points in a single show.
