

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Section 1: A dog awarded winners at a championship show held under these Dog Show rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5), and the determinations of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2: The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded Winners shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETING*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

* includes the dog awarded Winners.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners total all the dogs in the competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of breed, or Best of Opposite Sex, and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show.

NOTICE TO ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Every foreign born & owned dog entered in a CKC event must obtain an Event Registration #(ERN) within 30 days of the event. An ERN application must be completed & submitted along with a copy of registration documents from a CKC recognized foreign kennel club & the required fee of \$57.75. Download ERN application from the online forms section of CKC services or contact CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040.

Building hours are as follows: Thursday 4:00 to 11:00 pm. Friday - Sunday 6:00 am to 11:00 pm. There will be no watchman on duty - dogs left in the building will be left at owners/handlers own risk.

INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS:

1. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the CKC rules and regulations. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show.
2. The SK&OC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune to dogs, exhibitors, or partons. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or complete the Show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
3. Obedience entry fees will be refunded to exhibitors whose bitches are in season during the trials and must be withdrawn provided a veterinarian certificate is produced or the bitch is on hand for inspection by a club representative prior to the start of the trial.
4. Any dog that has earned its CD or CDX title in the USA is not eligible to enter the novice classes and must be entered in the B classes respectively.
5. Only dogs entered in the shows and trials shall be allowed in the show building.
6. SKOC will not be responsible for contracts made between the photographer and exhibitors.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs inside and outside. SKOC will excuse any exhibitor not cleaning up after their dogs. The City of Yorkton By-law also states that all dogs must be LEASHED within the city limits. All dogs must be kept under complete control at all times.

Specials Only - dogs which have a recorded CKC registration or Event Registration number and have attained the required points for Championship status. Should a dog which is entered in this class be found either not to be registered or has not completed the requirements for Championship status, all awards earned at the show will be cancelled. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.
