In payment of entry fees, the tendering of NSF cheques shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$45.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque. Fax entries and/or credit card payment will be accepted when accompanied by authorized VISA or MASTERCARD credit card number, expiry date and cardholder's name. 10% of total fee will be added for FAX/Credit Card entries. Customers whose charges are declined by the Bank Card Authorization Department will be assessed a service charge of \$45.00 for each transaction declined. Telephone entries are not accepted by the Show Secretary. Incomplete entries or entries received without fees, or entries received after the advertised closing date will not be accepted. There will be no refund on overpayments or duplicate entries. Please mail entries early to ensure that they are received before the closing date

Please Print Legibly, The Show Secretary will not be responsible for errors in the catalogue as a result of their inability to interpret your entry form.

Additional Rules and Notes

- *CKC Dog Show Rules require that the precincts must consist of all areas of the facilities reserved for the use of the Club exclusive of the parking area. Un-entered dogs, including puppies under six months of age, are not permitted within the precincts (This includes the commercial Booth areas).
- *Dogs are to be exercised in the designated area only.
- *Crates are permitted at RINGSIDE during the judging of your breed only,
- *Dogs left in the building overnight are understood to be left at the owner's/agent's own risk,
- *Any vehicle parking in the handicapped designated area must display handicapped authorization.
- *The show building will be closed at 10pm each day.

- *The building must be vacated (and left clean) one hour after Best In Show on Monday.
- *Any exhibitor who allows their dog to defecate or urinate inside or outside the buildings without immediately cleaning up or arranging for a prompt clean-up may not be permitted to exhibit at any future shows held by these clubs.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

- (a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed
- (b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration
- (c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered. A listing fee of \$8.95 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 8.2: INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled.

Section 8.6.2: DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees. Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitor who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order, cash or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 14.1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

CHAPTER 5 - SHOW OFFICIALS

Section 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

Canadian Kennel Club Non Member Participation Fee (April 2011)

- A non member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC.
- · The non member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be awarded, the non member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

REGULAR CLASSES OFFERED

CONFORMATION: The following classes will be provided, divided by sex. **REGULAR CLASSES**

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

12 – 18 MONTH CLASS 12 months and under 18 months on the day of the show.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES:

No dog may be entered in both Novice "A" and Novice "B", Open "A" and Open "B" at the same trial. In determining class eligibility, if a dog shall have won a particular title before being entered or moved up, the handler shall have been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores for the required title. (However, a dog may continue to be exhibited for 60 days in a class after winning a particular title.)Dogs fulfilling the requirements for a title may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the show secretary at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.

PRE-NOVICE - The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Novice classes. The Pre-Novice class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 5 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of C.D. may enter the Pre-Novice class.

NOVICE A - The Novice A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

NOVICE B - The Novice B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises.

NOVICE C - The Novice C class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title C.D. or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in Novice C indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs in the Novice C class are not eligible for High In Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE - The Novice Intermediate class is an elective class and earning this title is not a requirement to enter the Open classes. The Novice Intermediate class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a C.D. or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class The same handler must handle the dog in all 6 exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs may be entered in the Novice Intermediate class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

New-OPEN HA - The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.

New Open18A -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.

New-OPEN HB - The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes.

New-Open 18B – The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes

UTILITY A - The Utility A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch. title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

UTILITY B - The Utility B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines will be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each will be used approximately the same number of times.

Change to Obedience Rules & Regulations: Open Class

(Effective January 1, 2018)

There are changes to the Obedience Trial Rules effective January 1, 2018. However, we want to provide advanced notice regarding the change to the Open Class A & B.

Exhibitors will now have options within the Open A and B classes and still achieve the same titles.

The Open A Class and the Open B Class will each have 2 options. Exhibitors must indicate on the entry form which option they choose when they complete their entry form.

In Open A, exhibitors can choose between entering into Open HA (which remain as in the existing rules as Open A), or Open 18A (which also follows the existing rules except that the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises, and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.)

In Open B, the exhibitor can choose between entering into Option HB (which remain as in the existing rules as Open B), or Option 18B (which adds in the new Change of Position Exercises).

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided here under. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by thejudge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group. A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earnedin attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Best in Show (5 points)(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title. Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship. A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. For example, a dog that wins first in group and then wins Best in Show, earns 10 points, not 15.

The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Additional Requirements To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **PACIFIC DAYLIGHT TIME.**
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. FVDF has a zero tolerance of abuse of any description involving any person involved with the FVDF shows, including spectators.

CONFORMATION

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex.

REGULAR CLASSES

JUNIOR PUPPY - 6 months & under 9 months on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY- 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

12-18 MONTH CLASS - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

OPEN CLASS - shall be for all Dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY - This class will NOT be divided by sex. A dog may be entered for "Specials Only" and such dog shall compete for Best of Breed award. If eligible it must compete for the award of Best of Opposite Sex. All awards the dog earned at the show will be cancelled if, at the time of closing of entries for the show, the dog was not registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or if the dog

has not earned all the championship points required for championship status. The entry of a Listed Dog in this class is NOT allowed.

EXHIBITION ONLY - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

Smoking Bylaws: This is a NO SMOKING venue. Electronic smoking devices and other oral smoking devices are included in this bylaw.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS: Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event 3Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$59.40 plus 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. A CKC ERN registration form can be downloaded from the CKC website: http://www.ckc.

<u>CCN NUMBER</u> allows mixed breeds and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in the CKC Performance Events: Agility; Obedience and Rally Obedience. To enter any Trial, the dog MUST have a CC Number. A dog is this category may not be entered as "Listed". The application form for the CCN can be found on the CKC website, under Forms On-Line, Registration. NON- MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members. \$59.40

THE AUTHORITIES OF ANY SHOW MAY:

- (A) Decline to accept entries for just cause and/or
- (B) Refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show grounds on account of disease or viciousness.

In the case of Non-acceptance, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have claim or recourse against the organization holding the show, or any official connected therewith for the refusal of any entry.

ATTENTION: FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you sent a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please DO NOT make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds.

BORDER CROSSING:

A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this Certificate and MUST be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry into the US.

ZERO TOLERANCE – Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Fraser Valley Dog Fanciers Shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit. Including and not limited to suspension from attending the event for a specific period of time in the future, including permanently.

Definition of Bullying: Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people. Examples include:

- insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits
- spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo
- berating/belittling an individual
- unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others
- giving insulting nicknames
- engaging in practical jokes that humiliate
- undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work
- physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates
- mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms
- yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles
- intruding on a participant's privacy by pestering, spying or stalking
- physically abusing or threatening abuse
- criticising a participant persistently
- constantly belittling a person's opinions.

This applies to interpersonal and electronic communications, such as email, FaceBook, text messaging, Twitter and Instagram. During Dates of the events.
