ZERO TOLERANCE – Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Kars Dog Club Shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit.

Definition of Bullying: Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people.

Examples include:

- insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits
- spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo
- berating/belittling an individual
- unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others
- giving insulting nicknames
- engaging in practical jokes that humiliate
- undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work
- physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates
- mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms
- yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles

*** RESTRICTED TO AMATEUR COMPETITORS WHO HAVE BEEN SHOWING DOGS <u>LESS THAN 5 YEARS</u>

Dog must be entered at <u>all 4 All-Breed Shows</u> for eligibility to participate in Novice Owner/Hander & MUST be handled all the way through by Novice Owner/Handler at all levels for the entire event.

Baby Puppies, Veteran and Altered are not eligible for this competition

- Novice Owner / Handler Box <u>must be checked</u> on entry form (NOH will be indicated in both the catalogue and on the Ring Steward sheets.)
- This is open to all non-professional owner / handlers. Professional defined as anyone
 who has been hired to assist or help a handler (at the KARS DOG CLUB event) or
 paid to handle or received remuneration or a licensed / permit judge. Dogs must be
 NOH throughout the competition.
- 3. Judging of **NOH** will take place after Breed Judging Competition unless automatic.
- 4. NOH, Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs eligible to compete for BB.
- 5. If the Best of Breed dog is NOH, it will automatically be the NOH BB.
- If ineligible, then the next highest NOH placement will compete against the eligible dogs of the opposite sex.
- Should none of the BB competitive dogs be NOH then any NOH dogs (not directly or indirectly defeated in the classes by an NOH dog) will be invited back.
- The NOH BB dogs will compete for Best NOH in Group immediately after Regular Group Judging.
- 9. Should the Regular Group 1st dog be NOH then it will be automatically OH in Group.
- 10. If no NOH places in the Group (1-4) then all BB NOH dogs will be called into the ring for NOH Group Judging.
- 11. If the BIS dog is NOH, then it will automatically be NOH BIS

A flat ribbon will be offered for Best NOH in Breed, a Rosette for Best NOH in Group, and a Rosette and \$100 Sponsored by Kars Dog Club, Prize Sponsored by PURINA & Treasure Coast (Saturday & Sunday) for Best NOH in Show.

*** If you are a NOVICE OWNER / HANDLER make sure that you check off the box on the entry form in order to be eligible to compete.

KARS DOG CLUB – PERPETUAL TROPHY FRIDAY, JULY 19, 2019

*Perpetual trophy is retained by the Club.

The Severn Trophy for Best Canadian Bred in Show is donated by Owen & Belle Severn, (Merkur reg'd and Staffhaven perm reg'd.) for dogs from the Canadian Bred class on Friday.

In order to compete for this Trophy, dogs must be entered in the CANADIAN BRED class. Judging of Best Canadian Bred in Show will follow Best in Show and Best Puppy in Show. The Perpetual Trophy will be presented at the end of Show. A keeper trophy and/or prize will be donation to the Best Canadian Bred In Show.

VETERAN CLASSES (Saturday & Sunday) ALTERED CLASSES (All 4 Shows)

Veteran: In this class, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are:

- ♦ Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran .
- ◆ Best Veteran in Breed
- ♦ Best Veteran in Group
- ♦ Best Veteran in Show

A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

Altered: The breed standards for each breed shall be followed except as defined below. All disqualifications shall apply except for those which disallow sexually altered dogs from regular conformation competition. Eligibility for the altered class shall be limited to dogs over 6 months of age which have been spayed or neutered by veterinary procedure. Points may not be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. These classes shall be for any spayed or neutered dogs over 6 months of age. Dogs will be judged after the judging of the Best Puppy in Breed in the Regular classes, and after Veteran Classes. The awards for this class are:

- ♦ Winners Altered Male/Female Class
- ♦ Reserve Winners Altered Male/Female
- ◆ Best Altered in Breed
- ♦ Best Altered in Group
- ◆ Best Altered in Show

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS (Friday & Sunday)

Dogs must be entered in the Bred by Exhibitor class. No Canadian Champions of record may participate. The Breeder/Co-Breeder & Owner/Co-Owner MUST handle the dog in all classes (including Group level and onward) for all awards, for Best Bred by Exhibitor. There is no additional charge for this competition. Judging in this competition will be held after each official class is completed at the breed and group level by the regular breed judge. Each winner will be eligible to compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor in his or her respective groups. Each group winner of the Best Bred by Exhibitor will be eligible to compete for Best Bred by Exhibitor in Show upon completion of General Specials.

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case, may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership - with a written request for an ERN. Include full payment in the amount of \$62.40. - Returned cheques do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee of \$35.00

 cheque.
- There is no refund for duplicate entries. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
- Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified or barred from competition by action of the bench Committee.
- If because of riot, civil disturbance or acts of God, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries shall be made.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs, regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Change or cancellation of any entry after closing time is prohibited.
- The Club reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules.
- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of Judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners/Agents are responsible to have their dogs present when their classes are called to be judged.
- Exhibitors are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy.
 If space is at a premium, exhibitors must remove exercise pens if requested by the Show Superintendent.
- 10. It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to ensure that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- 11. The Kars Dog Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes to dogs, exhibitors or patrons
- The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE
