INFORMATION ON THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

THE AUTHORITIES OF ANY SHOW MAY:

- (A) Decline to accept entries for just cause and/or
- (B) Refuse to receive or may remove any dog from the show grounds on account of disease or viciousness.

In the case of Non-acceptance, the fee shall be returned with the reason for non-acceptance. No one shall have claim or recourse against the organization holding the show, or any official connected therewith for the refusal of any entry.

ATTENTION: FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you sent a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please DO NOT make cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds.

BORDER CROSSING:

A Rabies Certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require this Certificate and MUST be dated at least 30 days prior to re-entry into the US

<u>CCN NUMBER (Canine Companion Number)</u> Allows mixed breeds and unrecognized breed dogs to Participate in the CKC Performance Events: Agility; Obedience And Rally Obedience. To enter a Trial, the dog MUST have A CCN. A dog in this category may not be entered as "Listed".

Females in season as pertains to trial

When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must reach the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. The entry fee and listing fee will be refunded.

IN THE EVENT OF A POSTAL STRIKE:

CONFORMATION:

The following CKC conformation classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

Junior Puppy: for dogs 6 mths of age but under 9 mths of age.

Senior Puppy: for dogs 9 mths of age but under 12 mths of age

12-18 Months: for dogs 12 mths of age and under 18 mths of age

Bred By Exhibitor - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

Canadian Bred: for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded.

Open: for all dogs.

Specials Only: dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and have attained championship status may be entered in the 'Specials Only' class. Exhibition Only: for all dogs over 6 mths of age and eligible for registration with the CKC (non-competitive class).

Exhibition Only: dogs entered in this class may not compete in any regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.

Exhibition Only (3-6 months): puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months provided the Owner has also entered an eligible dog
In a Regular Class. These puppies may participate in Sweepstakes, if offered.

Veterans: Veterans will be divided Males and Females with a Best of Breed judged for each. The Best of Breed winner will go on to Best Veteran in Group and Best Veteran in Show. Dogs must be 7 years or older on the day of the show.

Altered: Altered will be divided Males and Females with a Best of Breed judged for each. The Best of Breed winner will go on to Best Altered in Group and Best Altered in Show. All dogs must be surgically altered to enter this show.

Baby Puppy (3-6 Mths):. For dogs 3 mths of age & under 6 mths of age – dogs will compete in this unofficial class for Best Male/Best Female, Best Baby Puppy in Breed, Group & Show. They do not compete for Winners.

To enter Veterans sweepstakes the dog must be entered in one of the regular classes or for exhibition only on the same day. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete provided they are entered in exhibition only.



ZERO TOLERANCE – Any individual initiating bullying tactics at the Shows will be asked to leave the show grounds premises immediately and for the remainder of the event (no refunds). A report will be filed with CKC and the Disciplinary Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit. Including and not limited to suspension from attending the event for a specific period in the future, including permanently.

Definition of Bullying: Refers to a range of behaviors in which targeted individuals are repeatedly, and over time, treated in a mean, insulting or abusive way. Bullying can be initiated deliberately or unconsciously. The affected person may feel upset, afraid, isolated, or humiliated. The bully sometimes acts alone and sometimes as part of a group of people.

Examples include:

- insulting a person's skills, looks, or habits
- spreading false or malicious rumors, gossip, or innuendo
- berating/belittling an individual
- unwarranted criticizing or ridiculing, especially in the presence of others
- giving insulting nicknames
- engaging in practical jokes that humiliate
- undermining or deliberately impeding a person's work
- physical gesturing that intimidates, offends, degrades, or humiliates
- mocking a person's accent, abilities or mannerisms
- yelling or shouting which intimidates, coerces, or belittles
- intruding on a participant's privacy by pestering, spying or stalking
- physically abusing or threatening abuse
- criticising a participant persistently
- constantly belittling a person's opinions.

This applies to interpersonal and electronic communications, such as email, FaceBook, text messaging, Twitter and Instagram. During Dates of the events.

GENERAL RULES COVERING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the Show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above Shows and Trials, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
- 2. The Show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 3. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the Show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the Show to see that this Rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the Rule, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indication that this Rule has been violated.
- 4. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the Show Grounds.
- 5. Dogs must be on the Grounds one hour before the judging of their Breeds, and may be removed when not required for further judging.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of Breed or Class Judging. No Ring shall be held up waiting Exhibitors or Handlers. Exhibitors and Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute Handlers available so that judging will not be delayed.
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these Shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his dog, regardless of how or by whom the Entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship Show held under these Rules cannot again be shown at a Show held under these Rules until the dog has been examined by an Official Committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$25.00 which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the Examining Committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this rule shall be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and Handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the Exhibitors and the Spectators we insist upon keeping our Grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please Exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging Ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, NOT in the vicinity of the Ring areas.
- 11. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fore, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club
- 12. Entry Fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- 13. The use of PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM will be kept to an absolute minimum. Therefore, IT WILL BE THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITORS TO HAVE THEIR DOGS AT RINGSIDE, when necessary. There will Be no paging for individual dogs.
- 14. The washrooms and shower facilities are strictly for human use by order of the Health Department. Offenders will be removed from the Grounds for the duration of the shows.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBERS: For the sole purpose of entering CKC events to acquire CKC degrees and titles, individual registration will no longer be required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs, instead they may apply for an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This number must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, scores or awards to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a photocopy of your foreign Certificate of Registration and the appropriate fee (currently \$58.50) with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC

Individual Registration Number for entering events only)

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION #1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a Championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5), and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

SECTION #2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

DOGS COMPETEING*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
POINTS AWARDED	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes the dog awarded Winners

To determine the number of points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all dogs in competition which were defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The system provides for additional Points if a dog awarded Winners also placed in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with 5 points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified or that is dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge, shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points (Absentees are not to be included). In order for a dog to be recognized as a Canadian Champion it must: (1) earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and (2) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN) (3) have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed or group level.

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. The title of Grand Champion shall not be awarded retroactively and all points towards this title must be achieved after the date of January 1, 2013.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship title.

OBEDIENCE CLASSES:

No dog may be entered in both Novice "A" and Novice "B", Open "A" and Open "B" at the same trial. In determining class eligibility, if a dog shall have won a particular title before being entered or moved up, the handler shall have been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores for the required title. (However, a dog may continue to be exhibited for 60 days in a class after winning a particular title.)

Dogs fulfilling the requirements for a title may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the show secretary at least 15 minutes before the start of the class.

PRE-NOVICE - The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Novice classes. The Pre-Novice class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 5 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercise. Only dogs that have not earned the title of C.D. may enter the Pre-Novice class.

NOVICE A - The Novice A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. No person who has trained or exhibited a dog that earned a C.D.X. title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.

NOVICE B - The Novice B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has not earned the title of C.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. The owner or any other person may handle a dog in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises.

NOVICE C - The Novice C class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned the title C.D. or any higher obedience titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 6 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Dogs may compete in Novice C indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs in the Novice C class are not eligible for High In Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title. Dogs may be entered in the Novice C class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE - The Novice Intermediate class is an elective class and earning this title is not a requirement to enter the Open classes. The Novice Intermediate class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed that has earned a C.D. or any higher obedience trial titles. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class The same handler must handle the dog in all 6 exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice Intermediate class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in Trial. Dogs may be entered in the Novice Intermediate class in addition to any other official or unofficial classes for which they are eligible.

New-OPEN HA - The Open HA class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the title of C.D.X. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate families. Only one dog per handler is allowed in this class, and that person must handle the dog in all exercises. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class. Group exercises in Open HA are out of site as before in the original open classes.

New Open18A -The requirements are the same as Open HA and the same rules except the Long Sit is replaced with Change of Positions Exercises and the Long Down is replaced with a Group Sit-Walk around.

New-OPEN HB - The Open HB class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D. Dogs which have earned the title of C.D.X. or any higher titles may enter in the Open B class. A dog may also be entered in the Utility Class in the same trial. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter or handle more than one dog in this class. The same handler must handle each dog in all 7 exercises unless he has 2 or more dogs entered. In such cases, he must have an additional handler for each extra dog when they are judged together in the group exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines is to be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to the exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each set will be used approximately the same number of times. Group exercises in Open HB are out of site as before in the original open classes.

New-Open 18B – The requirements are the same as Open HB and the same rules apply except the addition of the new Change of Positions Exercises. As described in the Open HA and Open 18A classes

UTILITY A - The Utility A class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch. title may not handle dogs in this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner or member of their immediate families. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises.

UTILITY B - The Utility B class shall be for any dog of any recognized or listed breed, mixed breed or unrecognized breed which has earned the title of C.D.X. or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The

same person must handle the dog in all exercises. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will choose which of the six numbered routines will be performed. This choice will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ring side at least 30 minutes before the start of the class. In future assignments, judges are required to alternate the six routines so that each will be used approximately the same number of times.

Rally Obedience Classes:

Rally ring size: 40 x 50

The following classes will be offered in each trial. Order of judging will be determined at the close of entries. Rally Novice B, Rally Intermediate, Rally Advanced A, Rally Advanced, B, Rally Excellent A, Rally Excellent B, Rally Master

RALLY NOVICE A:

Dogs competing in this class may not have earned the R. N. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE B:

Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY NOVICE INTERMEDIATE:

The Rally Intermediate Class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to enter Rally Advanced Classes. (CKC rules, 10.1.2) This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class (performed on leash, no jumps, no A or B division) may be entered indefinitely. Judges would ordinarily use the same course for it as for their Advanced Classes, substituting one other exercise for the jump required in Advanced.

RALLY ADVANCED A:

This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R. N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY ADVANCED B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.A. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Advanced A and Rally Advanced B at any one trial.

RALLY EXCELLENT A:

This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R. A. title, but have not earned the R. E. title or any CKC Obedience title other than P.C.D.. No handler who has exhibited a dog through its CKC C.D.X. title shall be eligible to enter this class. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is also a sit stay exercise after the finish sign. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT B:

This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.A. title. A dog completing the R.E. title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. There is a sit stay exercise after the finish sign.

All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A and Rally Excellent B at any one trial.

RALLY MASTER - This class will be for dogs that have earned the R.E. TITLE . A dog completing the R.M.title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class...A person may enter more than one dog in this class All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Refer to Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations for further information.

All exhibitors must be familiar with Rally Rules and Regulations effective: January 1, 2018.

The precincts of these trials are the rings and immediate area surrounding the rings of the show site at 5100 North Nechako Road. Dogs are not permitted in the buildings. Only dogs entered are permitted within the precincts of the trial.




