Please do not send entries by Registered Mail.**

## COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:

We will be following provincial and local COVID-19 guidelines


Any person found to be willfully disregarding these precautions will be ordered to leave the property, with no refund of any entry fees. We ask that you use your best judgement to protect yourself and those around you.

## GENERAL INFORMATION:

- The Event Chairman will be in full charge of the events which will be governed by CKC rules.
- Sprinter rule books are available from the CKC (updated January 2024)
- Entries made through Dogshow.ca will be acknowledged by email, with receipt.
- "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities" – CKC rule book, Section 19.7
- We welcome all exhibitors, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your needs known to the club in advance. Please contact the event secretary by May 12, 2024, to ensure that we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

## RUNNING THE EVENT:

- Bring shade and water for yourself and your dog.
- Do not leave dogs unattended. Tie outs are not permitted.
- Dogs run once per trial. There are 2 trials per day.
- Roll call / inspection will be done near the trial secretary tent.
- Give other dogs and handlers plenty of room
- Lameness or unfit dogs or bitches in season (by the opinion of the inspection committee) will be excused and their entries refunded (provided notice is given prior to or during roll call)
- Dogs not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No exceptions.
- Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure, however handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety or they will be refunded their entry and excused.
- The club reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- Muzzles, fitted, flat buckle collars (no tags) and catch collars are permitted. The dog may run 'naked'.
- Flexi leads, pinch / prong collars and shock collars are not permitted.
- No loose dogs on the property at any time. Any dog off leash when it is not your turn running will be charged a \$10 fine on first offense. Any dog off leash after the first offense will be excused for the weekend.
- **CKC rules state that 'It is recommended that an owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed.'**
- Your dog needs a catcher and a releaser. Please ensure the catcher is at the finish line and visible to the releaser before bringing the dog to the start. Teams managing more than one dog should have a third "runner" handler. Please ask for help during roll-call.
- This is a physically intensive sport. Ensure you properly warm up your dog before their run and cool down your dog after.
- Once your dog is completely cooled down and rested from their first run, check in with the trial secretary for your final inspection.
- No persons are permitted to walk the track during active competition. If the releaser enters the track more than 3 meters from the start line the team will be eliminated.
- The dog finishing their event must be caught, leashed, and exit the field before the subsequent dog may be permitted to enter the field.
- Clean up after your dog and yourself (including cigarette butts).

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted: however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

**No entry will be accepted without payment in full.** Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered nonpayment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. **Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy funds. Thank you!**

The owner of a dog entered in this event is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

### **WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:**

Please note: An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, but written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the event.

**ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS:** participation is open to all purebred and mixed-breed dogs at least 12 months of age that are:

- individually registered with the CKC, or
- have an Event Registration Number (ERN), or
- have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or
- have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed, or
- have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) if it's a mixed breed.
- have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

## EARNING POINTS:

The dog's time to complete the 100 meter dash is converted into Kilometers Per Hour (KPH). A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- (a) 18" or greater - handicap is 1.25.
- (b) 12" up to less than 18" - handicap is 1.5.
- (c) Below 12" - handicap is 2.0.

**Points** - 360 divided by the dog's time produces the dog's KPH which is multiplied by the dog's handicap to result in the number of points earned.

Example: a 14" tall dog takes 18 seconds to complete the course.  $360/18\text{seconds} = 20 \text{ KPH} \times 1.5 = 30 \text{ points}$ . Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

**Please be sure to enter the correct height category.  
If you are unsure of your dog's height, please measure them.**

## AWARDS AND TITLES:

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog that achieves a score. Ribbons will be distributed after both trials are complete for the day.

The titles dogs may earn in Sprinter events are:

- **Novice Sprinter (NS)** awarded to a dog that earns 150 points
- **Sprinter (S)** awarded to a dog that earns 500 points
- **Advanced Sprinter (AS)** awarded to a dog that earns 1000 points
- **Sprinter Excellent (SX)** awarded to a dog that earns 1500 points
- **Sprinter Excellent 2 (SX2)** awarded to a dog that earns 2000 points.
- **Sprinter Excellent 3 etc (SX3, etc)** each additional 500 points the dog adds a higher number

## ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS

<b>CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)</b>	
<b>a)</b>	An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. <b>The fee is \$64.00 + 5% GST.</b>
<b>b)</b>	In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
<b>c)</b>	"these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

## ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

<p>Effective Jan 1, 1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number <u>but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number</u>.</p> <p>This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). ### **RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

By signing this document, you will waive certain legal rights, including the right to sue or claim compensation following an accident. Please read this document carefully.

1. To hold the Lloydminster Kennel and Obedience Club including their members, directors, officers and employees (collectively defined as "LKOC "), as well as the owner and lessor of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim;
2. To hold LKOC harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by negligence of LKOC or any other person(s);
3. Assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save LKOC harmless from any and all loss and expense, including legal fees, by reason of the liability imposed by law upon the LKOC for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person(s), including myself, or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in the event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the LKOC or any other person(s);
4. That any cause of action, controversy or claim arising out of or related to the attendance at the event between the LKOC and myself or as to the construction, interpretation and effect of this waiver shall be settled by arbitration in the province of Saskatchewan; and
