Please NOTE:

This is a mid-week trial being held approximately a 1 hour drive from Sudbury Ontario. It is one day following the Quebec Trials and one day prior to the Sudbury Trials. This trial and the Sudbury trials will be held at separate event sites

Entry forms and fees must be submitted to the Field Trial Secretary prior to the Closing Date. The club will be unable to accept, cancel or alter any entry after the closing date.

Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Please make cheques **payable to South Western Ontario Spaniel Club**

Temporary Competition Number (TCN), replacing Listing: TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). The current TCN fee is \$12.00 per trial (i.e. per dog, per day).

Event Registration Number: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed"; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

Non-Member Participation Fee: An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian nonmember of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled. NOTE: it is less expensive to become a CKC member than to pay this fee each year!

Puppy Stake: "A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, section 2*

Limit Stake: "A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs that have not placed in an Open All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations. Chapter 10, section 3*

Open All-Age Stake: "An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 4*

Amateur All-Age Stake: "An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if, he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 6*

Points: Championship Points are awarded for placements in the All-Age Stakes, provided that there are 10 or more starters:

1st Place - 5 Points, 2nd Place - 3 Points, 3rd Place - 2 Points, 4th Place - 1 Point

Indignities: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 21, section 7*

6.5.1 Any dog withdrawn because of injury or illness, or for a dog that dies, or a bitch that comes into season shall be refunded in full by the event-giving club. Prior to paying such refund, the club may require an appropriate veterinary certificate.

6.5.2 The event-giving club is free to formulate its own policy with reference to refunds for other reasons provided that the terms thereof are clearly stated in the premium list.
