ELIGIBLE ENTRY

The trials are open to the following breeds Afghan Hound, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan Hound, Italian Greyhound, Irish Wolfhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound or Whippet that is one year of age or older on the date of the trial. Dogs eligible for individual registration or an ERN that are breeds designated as Sighthounds are eligible to enter, provided they have a Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

All entrants must

- (a) be individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number),
- (b) have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) be eligible for registration with the CKC

Hounds with breed disqualifications, altered or neutered are eligible to enter the lure coursing field trial. Hounds presently disqualified under CKC, AKC or ASFA coursing rules are ineligible for the Open Stake.

IMPORTANT NOTICE Hounds entering their first trial in Canada must be tested with another dog that is not a kennel mate, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. The CKC Hound Certification form, available from the Trial Secretary must be completed and submitted with the entry at the hound's first trial. Hounds with the following are exempt ASFA (FCh or LCM), AKC (QS, SC or DC), BUT are still required to submit the Hound Certification form at their first Canadian trial with their name and exempt title(s) circled.

RUNNING ORDER Dogs will be run by breed in alphabetical order on Saturday and reverse alphabetical order on Sunday. Mixed stakes will be run at the end. The running order is subject to change by the judges if this makes the running more efficient. Puppy and single stakes will be run after all of the other runs on Saturday.

BITCHES IN SEASON Bitches in season shall not be eligible to enter the test.

STAKES OFFERED

Open All hounds, including Field Champions.

Mixed Multiple breeds with entries of three or less, with the owners' agreement.

Best In Field Best of Breed (BOB) and Mixed Stake winners may compete (no points toward titles) on Sunday June 16, 2024.

Puppy Stake: Offered on Saturday and limited to 5 dogs only. This is open to dogs aged 6 to 18 months on the day of the event.

Single (Non-regular) Stake: Offered on Saturday and limited to 5 dogs only. This is open to any dog NOT entered in a regular class. This is NOT a regular stake.

Kennel Stake Offered on Saturday, determined by tally of scores. This is open to any 2 hounds entered in the regular stakes owned and kenneled by the same person. Total of scores earned in the regular stake shall determine the winner.

Breeder Stake Offered on Sunday, determined by tally of scores.

Stakes are defined in section 9.1 of the rulebook.

RIBBONS AND PRIZES Ribbons will be offered for all placements First place through to Next Best Qualified (NBQ). Rosettes and/or Prizes will be awarded to BOB winners and First in Mixed Stake, and to the Best In Field, Kennel Stake and Breeder Stake winners.

LURE FIELD TRIALCHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Per CKC Lure Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 7, Section 1 First place – four X number competing to a maximum of 40 points. Second place - three X number competing to a maximum of 30 points. Third place - two X number competing to a maximum of 20 points. Fourth place - one X the number competing to a maximum of 10 points. NBQ - no points awarded.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION Hounds not present at Roll Call will be scratched and entry fee not refunded. Bitches in season and lame hounds will have their entry refunded provided notice is given at or before Roll Call. The Club requests all competitors or spectators NOT to bring a bitch in season onto the grounds.

Stakes will be split if the entry in any breed reaches 20 or more at Roll Call.

All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing their hounds. Hounds may wear muzzles and/ or catch collars at their owners' discretion. Leg wraps must be in neutral colours.

Do not release your dog before the "T" in "Tally-ho" or the dog may be assessed a pre-slip penalty of between 1 and 10 points for that run by each judge.

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. CKC REGULATION It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

TRIAL SITE : No food available on site. Bring food, water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. These tests will be run **rain or shine**. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except during the trial. <u>Flexi leads will not be allowed on the trial grounds.</u> A port-a-potty will be available at the field. Wear appropriate footwear for traction and protection.

A \$10.00 fine will be levied against the owner of any hound loose on the field.

Clean up after yourself and your dog so that we will be welcome to use this site again. A \$10.00 fine will be levied against the exhibitor who does not scoop after their dog. Please properly dispose of trash (e.g. cigarette butts, dog poop) since this is an agricultural field. As courtesy to those who transport all trial equipment and garbage cans, please do not let your dog mark on them.



COVID 19 PROTOCOLS

The following protocols align with guidelines and orders from the BC Provincial Health Office. As the protective measures have been somewhat lifted, we urge you to continue to take care, wear masks if you wish, and abide by the rules - not everyone is fully vaccinated!

- Anyone who identifies as having symptoms, been out of the country within 14 days, testing positive or having been in proximity with someone testing positive will be given a refund and will not be allowed to attend the event.
- Handlers will receive a refund of entry fees if this event is cancelled due to changes to BC Provincial Health Officers orders or guidelines in effect closer to the event.
- Everyone arriving at the event will check in before proceeding to the field.
- Spectators, other than those coming with handlers to help with dogs are not encouraged to attend, in order to keep the numbers down.
- Continue to be aware of Social Distancing. Handlers need not approach volunteers (e.g. lure operator, huntmaster, field clerk, secretary)
- Handlers will check their own bitches for being in season and show the tissue to the inspection team.
- ose to wear masks.
- Dogs will be released as usual. Handlers may wear masks when releasing and catching their dogs.
- A portable toilet with a hand washing station will be available. Handlers are encouraged to bring their own hand sanitizers.

WAIVER

By signing this document you will waive certain legal rights, including the right to sue or claim compensation following an accident. Please read this document carefully.

In consideration of the acceptance of the entry and the opportunity to have the dog judged, and to win a ribbon and points at the Lure Coursing Field Trial events to be held on June 15 & 16, 2024, I agree:

- 1. To hold the Western Gazehound Club including its members, directors, officers and employees (collectively defined as WGC), as well as the owner and leaser of the real property on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.
- 2. To hold WGC harmless from any claim for loss of this/these dog(s) by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of WGC or any other person(s).
