**ENTRY FEES:**

Entry Fees must be received before 9 PM, April 11, 2024 and only online payment through Dogshow.ca will be accepted. Dogshow.ca service fees (nonrefundable) are 10% of total fees +GST  
 Entries will not be changed and no refunds issued after this time except as specified in the “**REFUND**” section below and according to the Covid protocols.

## **VETERAN SPRINTERS !!!**

*Veteran sprinters is a new set of titles for dogs over the age of 7.*

What stays the same:	The differences:
Distance: 100 meters Maximum allowed time: 60 seconds Point calculation: Time converted to KPH multiplied by the handicap Handicap: Based on height at withers Dogs can run ONCE per event.	Titles will be earned at the following intervals: Veteran Novice Sprinter (VNS) =75 points Veteran Sprinter (VS) =250 points Veteran Advanced Sprinter (VAS) = 500 points Veteran Sprinter Excellent (VSX) = 750 points (VSX # ) for every additional 250 points.

**Clubs are not required to offer Veteran Runs**

*You **MUST** select the VETERAN box on your entry form in order for points to count towards veteran titles. If the selection is not made, your dog's points will go towards regular titles, regardless of their age.*

### **GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Purebred or mixed-breed dogs must be at least 12 months of age that:

- (a) Are individually registered with the CKC (have a CKC registration number),
- (b) Have an Event Registration Number (ERN),
- (c) Have a Performance Event Number (PEN),
- (d) Are eligible for registration with the CKC, or
- (e) Have a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN) if it belongs to a CKC listed breed
- (f) Have a Canine Companion number (CCN) if it is a mixed-breed

**Day of test entries will NOT be accepted at this test.** If the tests fill, waiting lists will be kept and dogs from the waiting list may be entered and added.

**NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:** CKC has a tracking fee for non-members. Please refer to the information about this policy on the CKC website:

**INSPECTION:** Inspection starts 15 minutes before your flight starts. It ends 5 minutes before your flight starts. **Dogs not present at inspection shall be scratched with no refunds** except in the case of some unforeseen circumstance and the event secretary has been notified. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

All dogs will be inspected for fitness prior to being allowed to run. Bitches will be checked to determine if they are in season. **Bitches in season will not be allowed to run.**

**ALL HANDLERS BRIEFING:** ALL handlers briefing is 5 minutes before the start of your flight. ALL handlers are expected to attend.

**REFUNDS:** **Sprinter is an athletic pursuit that requires your dog to be in very good condition. Your dog relies on you to ensure this.** Dogs that are injured prior to the test or deemed unfit to compete at inspection and bitches in season will be issued a refund (less applicable dogshow.ca fees)

**DOGS UNDER CONTROL:** Dogs are expected to be aroused and excited in the presence of the lure. Handlers must be able to control their dogs for everyone's safety. If they do not, they shall be refunded their entry and not allowed to run. Additionally, the Sprinter Committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.

**SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS:** Muzzles and catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. No flexi leads allowed. **No open-toed shoes allowed on the field.**

**YOUR TEAM:** CKC rules state that *"It is recommended that an owner or someone familiar with the dog stand at the finish in order to catch the dog once the course has been completed."*

**We would like to reinforce this recommendation. Please bring a "buddy" catcher or releaser to support your team.**

**OWNER RESPONSIBILITY:** The owner of the dog entered in this event is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of their dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our ribbon fund. Thank you!

**WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES:** An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. Written or electronic notification must be received by the Event Secretary no later than the official closing time and date. If written notification is not received, the dog will remain entered in the event. Dogshow.ca fees will not be refunded.

**TEST SITE:** Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs. These tests will be run rain or shine. All dogs must be under control, on a leash except when running the test. **Flexi leads will not be allowed on the test site.** Clean up after yourself and your dog. A bathroom is available. Food is not available on site.

**ACCOMMODATION OF A DISABILITY:** We welcome all exhibitors and spectators, including persons with disabilities. If you require accommodation of a disability, please make your accommodation known to the club in advance. Please contact the event secretary to ensure we can do our best to accommodate your needs.

**REGULATIONS:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. **CKC Regulation:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

The test will follow a Sprint & Go format. Dogs will run once during each test. Two tests will run concurrently in each flight, i.e., all dogs in a flight will run once, in order, for Test 1. They will run again in the same flight in order for Test 2. Handlers will then leave to make room for the next flight.

Handlers will be given an opportunity to indicate a flight preference before the running order is distributed. There are **no guarantees** handlers will be assigned to their requested flight so please plan accordingly. More instructions regarding logistics will go out to all handlers before the event.

**EARNING POINTS**

The dog's time to complete the 100 meter dash is converted into Kilometers Per Hour (KPH). A handicap system is applied to a dog's KPH to determine the number of points earned. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- (a) 18" or greater - handicap is 1.25
- (b) 12" up to less than 18" - handicap is 1.5.
- (c) Below 12" - handicap is 2.0.

**Points** - KPH multiplied by the dog's handicap. For example  $20 \text{ KPH} \times 1.5 = 30$  points. Points are rounded to the nearest whole number.

**Please be sure to enter the correct height category;  
If you are unsure of your dog's height please measure your dog**

## AWARDS AND TITLES

A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog that achieves a score.

A rosette will be offered to new title holders.

The titles dogs may earn in Sprinter events are:

Novice Sprinter (NS) = 150 points Sprinter (S) = 500 points Advanced Sprinter (AS) = 1,000 points Sprinter Excellent (SX) = 1,500 points SX followed by a number (e.g. SX2) for every additional 500 points.	Veteran Novice Sprinter (VNS) =75 points Veteran Sprinter (VS) =250 points Veteran Advanced Sprinter (VAS) = 500 points Veteran Sprinter Excellent (VSX) = 750 points Veteran SX followed by a number for every additional 250 points.

In consideration of providing the opportunity to attend, practice, participate, compete in and/or be judged in dogs sports including but not limited to lure coursing, coursing and/or chase ability practice and permitting my use of its services, equipment and other facilities as subsequently agreed, and for other goods and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged, I, the identified Participant agree and certify as follows:

To hold the Western Gazehound Club including its members, directors, officers and employees (collectively defined as WGC) as well as Lynn Haywood as the owner of this property at 16378 50TH Avenue, Surrey, BC on which the event is held, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or things by the act of myself or my dog(s) while in or about the event or practice premises or grounds near the entrance thereto and I assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.

To hold WGC harmless from any claim for loss of this/these dog(s) by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise and from any claim for damage or injury, even if such loss or damage/injury was caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of WGC or any other person(s).
