SHOW ETIQUETTE

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. (See Section 19.7)

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rul to the CKC within 14 days of the action. (Conformation Show Rules and Regulations 4.1.5.)

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING: No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it: 1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease; 2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event); 3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease. Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

CKC NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

The Non-Member Participation Fee applies to dogs wholly owned by a resident of Canada who is not a member of the CKC; it is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You."

Junior PuppyA dog between 6 & 9 months on the day of the show.

Senior Puppy......A dog between 9 & 12 months on the day of the show.

12 - 18 MonthsA dog between 12 & 18 months on the day of the show. Canadian BredA dog which is born in Canada. No champions of any country

Bred by Exhibitor....The handler of the dog is also the breeder and owner.

Open ClassAll dogs.

Specials OnlyCanadian Champion dogs only.

Junior Handling - Conformation

Saturday, August 10 & Sunday August 11, 2024- Judges TBA,

All Juniors should register with the Show Secretary no later than ½ hour prior to posted judging time each day.

Best Over Junior - Prize & Rosette

1st through 4th in each competitive class - Ribbon

All other entries receive a participant ribbon. All Pee Wee handlers will receive a monetary prize.

All dogs must be entered in one of the Official classes or Exhibition Only on the day of the competition.

Class Structure-Junior Handling Conformation

Peewee Handlers 4 years of age up to 6 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year. This is a noncompetitive class.

Junior Novice Handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Junior Open Handlers 7 to 10 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 first places with competition.

Intermediate Novice Class Handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have not won 6 first places in the same class with competition.

Intermediate Open Class Handlers 11 to 14 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year, who have won 6 places with competition and for any handler who has progressed through the Junior Open Level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Senior Novice Handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have not won 6 first places with competition in this class. Handlers from the Intermediate levels progress to this class.

Senior Open This class is for handlers 15 years of age as of December 31st of the year preceding the competition year and up to 18 years of age, who have won 6 first places with competition, in the Senior Novice Class, and for any handler who has progressed through the Intermediate Open level and feels that he has enough experience to compete at this level.

Best overall is optional at the discretion of the host club. Junior handlers are eligible to compete in the above class structure from their seventh birthday until they reach their eighteenth birthday.

TROPHIES & AWARDS

Rosettes will be awarded for BOB, BOS, BOW BPIB in the limited breed show.

Through the generosity of the friends and members of the Conception Bay Kennel Club a rosette will be offered for Best In Show, reserve Best in Show, Best Puppy in Show, Best Baby Puppy in Show, All Group placements, Best Puppy in Group and Best Baby Puppy in Group each day

Suitable prizes will be offered for Group First awards and General Specials..

GENERAL INFORMATION

Judging will not commence prior to 8:00 am

The show precincts will be a 150-foot (45m) perimeter from the exterior of the rings.

The venue will be locked each evening. Opening and closing times will be posted in the judging schedule.

Limited number of catalogues will be available at the show.

This is an outdoor show with no cover. Exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own pop-up tents.

No hydro or water hook-ups available.

RVs and Generators are permitted.

Exhibitors are requested to keep their grooming and crating areas clean and tidy.

Dogs not entered in these shows will NOT be allowed within the precincts of the show.

The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, governed by CKC rules.

If, because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the controls of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show or trial, no refund of Entry Fees will be made.

In the event of cancellation between the closing date and the opening of the show this show is forced to cancel due to provincial or federal restrictions related to Covid-19, the entry fees will be fully refunded.

Conception Bay Kennel Club and it's show officials will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs, exhibitors and spectators, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortunes however caused.

REMEMBER TO 'STOOP AND SCOOP'

GENERAL ENTRY INFORMATION

To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept entries reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list.

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. INCOMPLETE ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES.

TELEPHONE ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

It is your responsibility to verify the receipt of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date.

The Show Secretary reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to CKC Dog Show Rules.

Identification cards and judging schedule will be mailed / emailed as soon as possible after entries close.

Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and the New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC, has ruled that where a conflict arises between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.

Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made. Changes or cancellation of any entry after closing date is prohibited.

In the event that the dog is absent, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, disqualified, or barred from competition by action of the bench Committee, no entry fees will be refunded.

To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loudspeaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

Only dogs eligible for registration with CKC may enter this show and trial.

Conception Bay Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entries, subject to CKC rules.

Championship Points

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 + Points Allocated 0 1 2 3 4 5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points.

If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Winners, then all dogs defeated directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded Winners only, then all the dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section. Clarification: Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group. A dog awarded Winners that also places Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive

of any points earned at the breed and group level.

In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. 15.1.13 The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Opposite Sex, Best of Breed or group placing.

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex. Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh: Dogs Competing 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 & more 1

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Gold: (**GChG**) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements.

The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles, (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honoured up until July 1, 2022.

The CKC will not consider a request for any corrections to results if received more than 90 days following the date(s) of the event(s).
