NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and are punishable by discipline action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid in full before the test(s). Please make all cheques payable to Sunpoke Hunting Retriever Club.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian Dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted however, they are to be payable in Canadian Dollars. If you send a cheque in US Dollars, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "at Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Dollars. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS

Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non-CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. Bitches in season <u>MAY NOT</u> compete in the test(s). Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of a bitch in season, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary <u>BEFORE</u> the start of the test(s) to qualify for a refund.

Catalogue order will be determined by draw on June 11, 2024. This will be the running order unless prior arrangements are made with the Field Marshall. Catalogues will not be available at the event.

Ducks will be used for both land and water marks.

All qualifying dogs will be awarded a CKC Rosette.

Electronic collars (either dummy or alive) as well as prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by a dog on the grounds of a Hunt Test at any time during the event with the exception of those collars designed to curtail barking which may be worn by a dog while kenneled. There will be a designated area (land and water) available for airing your dog(s) on the test grounds. Contact the Field Marshall upon arrival at the test site to confirm location of both prior to airing your dog(s).

Section 3.8.1 Indignities to a Judge

A judge officiating at a hunt test held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the hunt test. It shall be the duty and obiligation of the club holding the hunt test to see that this rule is effectively carried out.
