Entry Fees (HST included) per dog, per test, per day:

Listing fee of \$11.30 (HST inc) for Temporary Competition Number (TCN) dogs without an individual CKC registration number, or PEN/ERN/CCN number must also be submitted.

Refunds will be given for bitches in season or dogs determined by a veterinarian to be unfit to compete. A Veterinarian Certificate must be submitted before the start of the test.

Entry and payment will be accepted through www.dogshow.ca . This service offers online payment via credit card, ApplePay, and Interac E-Transfer. Do not mail or courier entries directly to the secretary. Do not email entries or etransfer payment to the secretary. Such entries will NOT be accepted.

Please provide an email address with your entry in order to receive the catalogue and test site location information. Catalogue, running orders and test site addresses will be posted to DogShow.ca after closing. Printed copies for participants will not be available at the test. Please print your own or save a digital copy to your device.

Excerpt from CKC Rules & Regulation for Hunt Tests

Chap.18: Sec.7: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the Canadian Kennel Club any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred."

For Your Information:

- The marshal is in control of the stake. Do not approach the judges directly. Ask questions during the handler's meeting at the start of each test. Otherwise, direct inquiries through the marshal.
- Please check in with the stake marshal upon arrival at your stake. Please report to Master Hunter first if double-staked and running a Master dog. It is the responsibility of the handler to inform the marshal if they have dogs running in other stakes. The marshal has the authority to move dogs for the efficiency of the test. Please get your dog promptly and report to the holding blind when asked to do so.
- Game birds shall be used.
- Shotguns may not necessarily be used. However, handlers at SH and MH will be required to handle a gun and/or replica during the test, and handlers in JH may be asked to carry a gun/replica. At all levels the gun/replica shall be treated as though it is a real firearm. Gun safety is paramount, and unsafe gun handling can result in the handler's removal from the test.
- All handlers and observers must wear dark or camouflage clothing.
- We are a small club. It "takes a village" to put on a test. Handlers are advised that they may be asked to help operate a gun station when they are not running. Please pitch in if asked.
- Rosettes will be presented at each test site at the conclusion of each stake.
- No meals, drinks, or snacks will be available on site. Please bring your own.
