Listing Fee: A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. The current listing fee is \$11.50 (\$11.50 US) per trial (i.e. per dog per day).

Event Registration Number: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed"; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

Non-Member Participation Fee:

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".

Points: Championship Points are awarded for placements in the Amateur Championship Stake, provided that there are 12 or more starters: The winner of the National Amateur Championship Stake will automatically become a Canadian Amateur Field Trial Champion and is also entitled to be designated "National Amateur Spaniel Champion."

1st Place - 5 Points, 2nd Place - 3 Points,

3rd Place - 2 Points, 4th Place - 1 Point

CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 12, section 2

Indignities: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue." *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 21, section 7*

Water Test: Water test will be Saturday October 5th at the discretion of the field trial committee.

Puppy Stake: “A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, section 2*

Limit Stake: “A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs that have not placed in an Open All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 3*

Amateur All-Age Stake: An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age, on the day of the trial at which the stake is being judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stakes must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur. *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, section 5*

Open All-Age Stake: “An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 4*
