The Calgary Pointing Dog Club will conduct a licensed field trial for all pointing breeds on the Buck Mountain Provincial Grazing Reserve, near Breton, Alberta. This trial is held under the Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club, Suite 400, 200 Ronson Drive, Etobicoke, Ontario, M9W 5Z9

Courses and Birds: Native Sharptail and Ruffed Grouse, pen raised pheasants, partridge or quail. The Open Puppy will be single course, with no birds released and no bird field. All other stakes will be run on a single course with birds released on the back course only. At the discretion of the Field Trial Committee courses may be added, deleted or altered to accommodate as many dogs as possible.

LOCATION

From junction of hwy. 20 and Sec rd. 616 at Breton, go 18.6 km west, south 8 km. on Oak Bay Road, look to the left (East) side of the road. The club is grateful to have the use of these excellent grounds and asks for your cooperation in keeping them clean by using garbage bags provided. Parking is restricted to the camping area. No smoking allowed on course.

The GSPFCA is grateful to The Buck Mountain Grazing Reserve and Manager Rod Vancuren for the use of these grounds. Please respect and abide by all good neighbour rules. Please clean up all garbage before leaving no matter how small.

MOST IMPORTANT: NO SMOKING OR OPEN FLAME OF ANY KIND WILL BE PERMITTED OUTSIDE OF YOUR VEHICLE. THIS AREA IS EXTREMELY DRY AND SENSITIVE TO THE SMALLEST SPARK. PLEASE RESPECT THE LAND OWNERS WISH AND ABIDE BY THIS RULE.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Running and Handling: Horseback Handling will be permitted in all stakes except Amateur Shooting Dog.

Tracking collars: The CPDC is allowing the use of electronic tracking collars in the trial. Only tracking collars that meet the CKC guidelines will be allowed. Participants must declare that they are using the tracking collars to the Field Trial Chairman and also to the judges. Garmin GPS collars are not approved for use in Canada and will not be permitted.

Collaring: Collaring a dog away after contact with game **will** be allowed.

Blank Pistols: .22 calibre or larger will be fired over all dogs with bird work in senior and derby stakes. Blank pistols will not be fired in the puppy stake.

Total Entries: Entries will be limited to the number of dogs that can be run in the available daylight hours Senior and Derby stakes are 30 min. and the Puppy stake will be 20 min. length. In order to accommodate as many dogs as possible in the event of a large entry, or any other unforeseen circumstances, a 20 min Derby stake and a 15 min. Puppy Stake may be run. At the discretion of the Committee, stakes may be rearranged or courses altered to accommodate as many entries as possible. This includes the addition of a birdfield.

Bitches in season: Bitches in season **will** be allowed to run in **Amateur Shooting Dog and Open Shooting Dog only.**

All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and Regulations and also the rules, conditions, and provisions of this Premium List. CKC Field Trial Rules are available from the CKC.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Camping allowed on the grounds in the area of the club tent from Friday May 17th to Monday May 20th, 2019. Facilities are limited, come prepared. Outhouses provided. LISTING FEE

The rules of the CKC require the payment of a listing fee of \$10.50 (for each stake entered) in addition to the entry fee of a dog for which no CKC registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is shown on the entry form. Exhibitors should note that the CKC does not confer a title on any dog until it is registered individually in the Club's records. Foreign born and owned dogs must apply for an ERN or Registration within 30 days of the first event entered. Competitors should apply for an ERN number from CKC so non CKC registered dogs can accumulate points won, toward a championship.

IMPORTANT!! READ THIS

All entries for this Field Trial are accepted on condition that the CPDC, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by animal or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this field trial.
