CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show.

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show.

12 to 15 MONTHS CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 15 months of age on the day of the show.

15 TO 18 MONTHS CLASS – This class shall be for any dog 15 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS – This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. Champions of any country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS – This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler MUST be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – This class shall be for all dogs and divided by colour: Black, Chocolate, Yellow.

VETERAN CLASS – This class shall be for dogs over 7 years of age and older on the day of the show. Class will be divided: 7 years to under 9 years, 9 years to under 12 years, and 12 plus years. The winners of each class in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

FIELD DOG CLASS – Dogs entered in this class must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. This class is to be judged prior to Best of Breed judging and the winners in each sex will compete for Best of Breed. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS – This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Canadian Championship status. NOTE: A Listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided that the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class MUST be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing fees WILL NOT be refunded.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

EXHIBITION ONLY – all dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class MAY NOT COMPETE in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY.

BABY PUPPY – This class is for dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

STUD DOG – This class shall be comprised of the stud dog and two or more of his get. Ownership in this class need not be identical. The stud dog may be neutered and must be entered in a regular class or in Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a regular class.

BROOD BITCH - This class shall have the same requirements as the Stud Dog and Get. The brood bitch may be spayed.

BRACE – This class shall be for two dogs of the same breed (not necessarily the same sex). A Brace must be handled by one person on one lead.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered Classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age, which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points MAY NOT be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class will be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed and divided by sex.

Juvenile Sweepstakes

This class is open to all Labrador Retrievers from 3 months to under 18 months regardless of their place of birth; dogs must also be entered in one of the regular classes at this specialty. Classes will be divided by sex as follows:,

- 3 to 6 months,
- 6 to 9 months,
- 9 to 12 months,
- 12 to 15 months
- 15 to 18 months.

For final judging the first place puppy from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Money received as entry fees for the Sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows: Best in Sweepstakes: Rosette and 25% of total entry fees Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes Rosette and 15% of total entry fees First in Class: Rosette and first place winners will divide the remaining 35% of the total fees for the Sweepstakes

All other placements will receive a Rosette.

Veteran Sweepstakes

This class is open to all Labrador Retrievers 7 years and older regardless of their place of birth. Dogs must also be entered in one of the regular classes at this Specialty, or in Exhibition Only. Spayed or neutered Labrador Retrievers are eligible for this event.

Classes will be divided by sex as follows: 7 to 9 years, 9 to 11 years and 11 years and older.

For final judging the first place Veteran from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes.

Money received as entry fees for the Veteran Sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes: Rosette and 25% of total entry fees

Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes Rosette and 15% of total entry fees

First in Class: Rosette and first place winners will divide the remaining 35% of the total fees for the Sweepstakes

All other placements will receive a Rosette.

The balance of 25% of the sweepstakes money received in both sweepstakes is retained for administration purposes.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided here under. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

*Dogs	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 & More
Competing						
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*Includes the dog awarded Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by thejudge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Breed at the show, then all dogs competing in the breed, including Specials Only, shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, then all dogs of the same sex including those competing in Specials Only shall be included in the total. If a dog awarded Winners is also awarded directly or indirectly in the breed shall be included in the total. If a dog is awarded Winners, then all dogs of the same sex in the class competition shall be included in the total. The number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be determined by the highest award earned and calculated as per this section.

Clarification:

Example of directly or indirectly defeating: If the Winners Bitch is awarded Best of Opposite Sex but not Best of Winners, the Best of Winners Dog shall be deemed to have indirectly defeated the Specials bitches, and is thus entitled to add them to the number of dogs and bitches defeated.

In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

A dog may not be credited with more than five (5) championship points in a single show.

Permission shall be granted a club or clubs to hold shows in such a way that any dog may earn three (3) sets of championship points on the same day, provided that one or more of those sets of points is awarded at a specialty for that breed or group. A dog awarded Winners that also lplaces Best in Show at an all-breed conformation show shall be credited with five (5) championship points inclusive of any points earned at the breed and group level. In order for a dog to be recognized as a champion and its owner provided with a championship certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges; (b) be registered in the records of the CKC, have an Event Registration Number (ERN) or have a Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN); (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

The Board interprets the words "earn at least 10 championship points under 3 different judges" to mean: (a) Three (3) or more Winners awards at not less than three (3) different shows, under three (3) different judges at the breed level; (b) each of the three (3) judge's awards must be one or more championship points won at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing; (c) all points required for championship status may be earned at Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or group placing.

Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (a) Grand Champion Point System

Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level:

Best in Show (5 points)(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title. Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship. A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

Grand Champion Excellent point system

Win	Points
First in Group or Best in Specialty Show	5
Second in Group of Best of Opposite Single-Breed Specialty Show	4
Third in Group	3
Fourth in Group (Note: No points are acquired if no other dog is present in the group.)	2
Best of Breed (To earn the breed point, at least five (5) dogs must be shown at breed level.)	1
Best in Show or Best in National Specialty Show	10

Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. For example, a dog that wins first in group and then wins Best in Show, earns 10 points, not 15.

The title of Grand Champion Excellent shall not be awarded retroactively. However, dogs that have been awarded the Grand Champion title prior to January 1, 2013, will be awarded the Grand Champion Excellent title on application to the CKC.

Additional Requirements To attain a Grand Champion Excellent title, a dog must have been awarded a CKC performance title from any CKC event. A CGN, Herding Tested certificate or Chase Ability Program title are not considered performance titles for the awarding of this title.

Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the nonmember participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

EXTRACTS FROM CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

JUDGES – SECTION 4.1.3

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively carried out.

SHOW OFFICIALS - SECTION 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.3

Entry forms received by the CKC, which are incomplete and/or contain incorrect information may result in awards being cancelled.

ENTRY FORMS – SECTION 8.2.5

An error in an age-specified class, the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show.

ENTRIES - SECTION 8.3.1

Every dog entered in a conformation show must be one of the following:

- a. registered with the CKC
- b. have an Event Registration Number

c. eligible for registration with the CKC, or

d. if it belongs to a listed breed, it must have a Miscellaneous

Certification Number (MCN)

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES – SECTION 8.6.2

A Club may refuse any entry form from an exhibitor known to have tendered a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card unless entries are accompanied by cash, money order or certified cheque.

DISQUALIFICATIONS – SECTION 14.1.4

Once a dog has been disqualified for any reason at a conformation show, it may not be entered or shown at another show until the dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by the dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS AND TRIALS

1. The Club Reserves The Right To Remove Any Person From The Show. The Show Superintendent Shall Have Full Control Of These Shows And Trials, Which Will Be Governed By CKC Rules.

2. A Dog Excused By The Show Superintendent Or Veterinarian For Any Reason Shall Not, Compete In Any Class For Any Awards For Balance Of The Show.

3. The Show Committee Will Use Due Care And Diligence For The Welfare Of Dogs And Exhibitors, But Will Not Be Responsible For, Or Assume Any Liability In The Event Of Accident Or Misfortune To Either Dogs, Exhibitors, Spectators Or Vendors.

4. Dogs Must Be On The Grounds 1-Hour Prior To The Judging Of Their Breed. The Owner Of A Dog Entered In These Shows Is Entirely Responsible For Any Error In Entering The Dog

5. Exhibitors And Handlers Will Be Responsible For Their Dogs And Equipment Left At The Show Grounds.

6. Dogs To Be Exercised In Designated Areas Only, Not In Vicinity Of Rings

7. All Recreational Units Will Have Buckets Underneath For Their Sink Drains. Anyone Found Discharging Water On The Grounds Will Be Removed By Order Of The Health Department, And May Be Subject To A Fine.

8. If, Because Of Civil Disturbance Or Other Acts Beyond The Control Of The Club, It Is Impossible To Open Or Complete The Show, No Refund Of Entry.

9. Dogs Must Be On Leash At All Times On The Show Grounds Or Within The Show Building With The exception Of The Obedience Rings

10. See The All FVDF Premium List For All Other Rules That Pertain To This Event Venu.
