Day of Show entries will be accepted between 8:00 am and 9:15 am, as space permits. All DOS entries must be made in person and paid in cash at the show site.

Entries open on September 22, 2019 on a first received basis. Entries will continue to be accepted until limits are met or until October 09, 2019.

Competitors do not earn qualifying scores toward any Barn Hunt title when participating in a Fun Test.

Run Order - Fraser Valley Ratters reserves the right to change the run order based on entries received and shall send out the final class run order and judging schedule TWO DAYS prior to the start of the test. Dogs will be staged in blinds of no more than 5 dogs, with dogs handled by the same person in separate blinds.

#### Directions

**From Mission**, take the Lougheed (BC 7) eastbound. Right on Cameron Road (first right after you come off Woodside Mountain.) Right on Hunt Road (past the railroad tracks, then between the farm and the rose garden.) Follow to the end of the road, which ends in the farmyard.

From the Trans Canada (Highway 1) eastbound, take Exit 135 (BC 9) towards Agassiz/Harrison Hot Springs. Follow through Agassiz on BC 9. At 4 way stop, go left on BC 7 towards Mission. Left on Cameron Road. Right on Hunt Road (past the railroad tracks, then between the farm and the rose garden.) Follow to the end of the road, which ends in the farmyard.

#### **Exhibitor Information**

#### Crating

All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times unless actively working. The test will be held in a concrete floored barn. Dog crating will be in a covered barn nearby. There is parking nearby for those who wish to crate in or near their cars. Crating and parking spaces are first come, first served.

#### Collars and Leads

Electronic collars, bark collars, muzzles and head halters are not allowed on Barn Hunt show grounds. Collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced are strongly recommended for the ring. No flexi leads in the barn.

#### Bitches in Season

Bitches in season MAY compete at a Barn Hunt Fun Test. They will be run at the end of each class and will be crated and pottied in a designated area. Bitches in season MUST wear pants at all times except when being pottied. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the start of the test and inform exhibitors at the general briefing.

# Height Divisions (at withers)

Small - 13" and under

Medium - 13.1" to 18"

Large - over 18"

#### Dog Aggression

Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner towards another dog or a person may be dismissed from the test at the discretion of the judge and/or test committee.

## Animal Safety

The safety of our dogs and rats are a primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and physically able to perform all course elements.

#### **Awards**

Certificates will be awarded for 1st through 4th in each height category of the A classes, as well as High In Class and 1st through 4th in the B classes. Special awards may be made at the discretion of the Test Committee.

#### Refunds and Cancellation Policy

After the closing date, entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the test committee.

Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. No event fee will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of god, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee.

Abuse of any kind towards volunteers, dogs, rats, competitors, judges or test committee will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from this event.

Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog will be eligible for a 75% refund of entry fees paid upon receipt of a note from a veterinarian. The note must be dated and emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary prior to the close of the test.

#### Returned Check

A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$35 fee for all returned checks

#### **Smoking**

There is NO SMOKING on the event site. If you must smoke, please do so inside your vehicle or off the event site.
