worldwide. In the last fifteen years, United Kennels has had more than twenty different dogs hold the #1 position both in the US and Thailand. Recognized throughout the world for his in-depth knowledge of canine structure and breed type, Ekarat is one of very few individuals licensed to judge All-Breeds everywhere dogs are exhibited. He is routinely the guest of fanciers in U.S.A , Canada , South America , Russia , Scandinavian, Australia , New Zealand , Japan , China , South East Asia as well as his native Thailand .



Francis Smith

Francis is and FCI and FCA All Breed Judge and Director of the FCA National Genealogical Registry. She is the founding member and President of the Yorkshire Terrier Club Argentino. Involved with dogs since childhood and has grown up experiencing the dog world as an exhibitor, groomer, breeder, Judge, Club President and member and Director of the FCA Registry. She breeds Yorkies under the prefix of "Las Heras" as well as has bred the "Von der Hall II" Wire Dachshunds, "Francesca" Bichons and "Viva Vaia" Shar-Pei. Her expertise ranges far into the world of Samoyeds, Argentine Dogo, Siberian Husky, Old English Sheepdogs, Pugs, Basset Hounds, Scottish Terriers and Golden

Retrievers.

Her work in pursuit of Purebred Dogs doesn't stop there: she is a published author of many Cynology works and courses as well as being involved as a Keynote Speaker and participating in Breeder and Judges Education.

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 6 months of age and under 9 months of age on the day of the show

SENIOR PUPPY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog 9 months of age and under 12 months of age on the day of the show

12 to 18 MONTHS – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show.

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada. Champions of an country are excluded.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring by owner/breeder. The handler **MUST** be the owner/co- owner **AND** breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs.

SPECIALS ONLY CLASS - This class shall be for any dog that has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. Note: A Listed dog may be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class **MUST** be received by the Show Secretary **ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED**. Listing Fees **WILL NOT** be refunded

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **MAY NOT COMPETE** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades **ONLY**

BABY PUPPY – This class is for all dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show.

VETERANS CLASS - This class is for dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in these classes may be spayed or neutered.

UNOFFICIAL CLASS

BREEDER/OWNER/HANDLER - You must be entered in a Regular Class to be eligible and handle the dog at all levels to be eligible for BOH in Breed, BOH in Group and BOH in Show. There is no entry fee but you must enter online or check the entry form in the box provided for mailed in entries. No exceptions.

SEXUALLY ALTERED CLASSES

Eligibility for the Altered classes shall be limited to dogs over six months of age, which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. Points **MAY NOT** be carried from the regular competition judging to the Altered class judging. This class will be judged upon the completion of Best of Breed.

Two classes **ONLY** will be offered:

Altered Male and Altered Female

Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each sex will be declared Winners and the second place winner from each sex will be awarded Reserve. The Altered Winners Male and Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best Altered in Breed.

Juvenile Sweepstakes

Saturday, June 20th, 2020, lunch break

Judges: Lydia Magnusson (Best Overall) & Janet Lostale

Juvenile Sweepstakes is open to all puppies six months and under eighteen months of age regardless of place of birth. All dogs must be entered in one of the regular official classes on the same day. Dogs will be judged in one of the following six classes (divided by sex):

Junior Puppy - 6 months and under 9 months
Senior Puppy - 9 months and under 12 months
Juvenile Puppy - 12 months and under 18 months

For final judging the first place puppy from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes.

Best in Sweepstakes - rosette & 45% of total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes
1st in Each Class - rosette & 5% of total fees collected for the Juvenile Sweepstakes
2nd thru 4th - flat ribbons

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all dogs 7 years of age and over and entered in a regular class or for exhibition only on the same day. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete provided they are also entered in exhibition only.

Dogs to be judged in one of the following four classes (divided by sex):

Junior Veteran - 7 years and under 10 years
Senior Veteran - 10 years and over

For final judging the first place winner from each of the classes will be brought together for the final judging of Best in Sweepstakes and Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes

Best in Sweepstakes - rosette & 35% of total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes
1st in Each Class - rosette & 10% of total fees collected for the Veteran Sweepstakes

25% of fees collected will be retained by the club to defray costs

Section 3.4.1 "Junior Handler with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

EXTENDED CENTER RING

Our second annual Parade of Breeds is scheduled for Saturday, June 20th at approximately 5:00 pm. Last year we had over 30 breeds showcased and it was well received and it was even showcased in a blog with the Canadian Kennel Club.

If you would like to participate in 2020 or think you would like to, please e mail Sandi Malcolm at mimicker@shaw.ca and let her know. Advising now does not mean you are committed to it, just interested so a number of possible breeds can be logged.

Dogs should be presented in show condition, and handlers too. This gives the best possible experience to our audience.

There is no cost to participate and you are welcome to set up a table around the ring with your dogs, and hand out

business cards and talk to the public about your breed of dog. No puppies or dogs to be sold at the show.

I will need breed descriptions, in writing no less than 1 week (7 days) before the show. No more than 6 lines about your breed – not your dog – your breed, the good, and not so good. What type of lifestyle they suit and wouldn't suit. They will be edited if too long. Send them to Sandi Malcolm at mimicker@shaw.ca.

We will be doing it a bit differently this year to ease fluidity in presentation. All dogs will be lined up alphabetically in a separate ring, and as the breed is called you will be welcomed into the ring. Breed signs will be well spread out inside the ring to enable all dogs and handlers have plenty of room. We will be using the extended center ring. Once everyone is in the ring, standing by your breed sign, our MC Grant Townsend will read your breed descriptions as you go around the ring and present your dog.

GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from:
The CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9 or online at www.ckc.ca

1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are PACIFIC TIME.
7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club.
12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

FIRE SAFETY RULES:

Extension cords may not be laid across an aisle.

Power bars are not permitted.

Aisles must be kept open at all times to allow everyone easy and speedy exit in case of emergency.

All designated FIRE LANES must be kept clear at all times or vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.

ADDITIONAL CLUB RULES:

Exhibitors will be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Violators will be asked to leave the show grounds.

Crates will be allowed at ringside during the judging of your specific breed only and must be removed immediately after. No Exceptions.

Dogs are not allowed in washrooms and must be on leash at all times on the show grounds or within the show building with the exception of the obedience rings.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that you will exercise control and restraint over the children in your care on the days of these shows.

The Club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or vendors/concessions. The Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.

Plastic sheeting must be under all exercise pens.

Dogs must be exercised in the designated areas. Dogs may not relieve themselves on or near the building. Failure to observe this rule may result in dismissal.

Any tape used in the building has to be easily removable and must be removed after the show is completed. Colored tape is not allowed. You must leave your setup in the same clean condition you found it in when you first arrived at the show.

No liquid waste is to be disposed of in garbage cans.

All RV units must have buckets underneath for their sink drains. Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed by order of the Health Department and may be subject to a fine.

No catering of any kind is permitted.

The club reserves the right of restricting exhibitors grooming space.

Grooming is not allowed in the Rally benching area.

Any videographer or photographer, other than the official videographer/photographer, that is going to take picture for which they will be remunerated will require written permission from the Nanaimo Kennel Club Show Committee and/or the official show videographer/photographer.

CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points Allocated*	0	1	2	3	4	5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed here under.

A class Dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a CKC Event Registration Number (ERN).

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Nanaimo Kennel Club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
