Directions to the Field Approximate GPS Coordinates: N 51 07 3.06 W 113 39 22.03 If you use Google Maps, Lyalta is the closest selection to the field. If your GPS wants you to take Twp Rd 250. Ignore it and take Twp Rd 252. Signs posted on Hwy #9 at Twp Rd 252 and at corner of Twp Rd 252 and Rge Rd 271.

From the North: QE Hwy #2 South to Stoney Trial Hwy #201. Follow Stoney Trial East to the Country Hills Blvd Exit (exit 68) Go East on Country Hills Blvd (Hwy # 564) for 17.2 km to Hwy #9. South on Hwy #9 3.2 km (2 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). East 1.6 km (1 mile) to Rge Rd 271. Right turn-South to first acreage.

From the South: QE Hwy #2 North to Stoney Trail Exit 234A. Exit East (right) on Stoney Trail and follow to Hwy #22X East Exit 96. Take Hwy #22X East to Langdon Corner (Rge Rd 272). Signage for Boulder Creek Golf Course. North on Rge Rd 272 to 4-way Stop at Langdon. Continue North (now on Hwy 797) to Hwy #1. Cross Hwy #1 onto Hwy #9. North on Hwy #9 for 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). At this point, follow directions from North.

From the West: Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Stoney Trial Hwy #201. Follow Stoney Trial to the Country Hills Blvd Exit (exit 68). At this point, follow directions from North.

From the East: Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Hwy #9. Turn Right on Hwy #9 and go North on Hwy #9 for 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). At this point, follow directions from North.

COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:

WE WILL BE FOLLOWING PROVINCIAL AND LOCAL COVID-19 GUIDELINES Please refer to <https://www.alberta.ca/> for the latest Provincial restrictions and guidelines pertaining to outdoor sports activities.

Any person found to be willfully disregarding these precautions will be ordered to leave the property, with no refund of any entry fees.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING/MASKS:

The Provincial physical distancing guideline of maintaining a minimum of 6 feet or 2 meters distance from others whenever possible must be adhered to at these events by volunteers and participants. We are asking that you stay in or near your vehicle except when running or exercising a dog. All participants will wear facial coverings (mask or face shield) over nose and mouth when not able to maintain social distancing such as dog inspections, handlers meetings, when releasing/catching dogs at start/finish line. Volunteers will wear facial coverings when in close contact with others. *NOTE: If you have a medical reason for not being able to wear a facial coverings, we kindly ask you to consider your health above all and to reconsider entering and wait for a time where we are able to lift the mask restriction.

Participants must provide their own mask or other suitable face covering.

We ask that you park 6 feet away from each other.

RUNNING THE EVENT:

Roll Call/Inspection will be done at everyone's car, instead of at the normal gathering area. The roll call committee will wear facial coverings at this time. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.

Huntmaster(s) will stand 6 feet from the dogs and will wear facial coverings.

Dogs will be released with 6 feet between them. Facial coverings will be worn by participants at the line. Dogs may be run in braces or singly rather than trios, for ease of distancing at start line.

Do not crowd at the secretary's area for run information or for results posting.

There will be a Paddock Master calling dogs to the line. Be aware of when it is your turn.

CLEANLINESS:

Sanitizer will be available in the gathering area. Bring your own hand sanitizer to use before and after touching your facial coverings, as well as any other incidences of touching objects with contamination potential.

Porta Potty – Please use the provided spray to sanitize the area after you use it, prop the door open for airflow when not in use. If you have a trailer/RV, please use your own toilet facilities.

FOOD: To comply with health and safety guidelines related to COVID-19, there will be no food or water provided on site. Participants will need to bring their own food/refreshments. Remember to provide for your dog as well.

WELLNESS: If on the days leading up to, or the day of these events you or any member of your household are exhibiting any of the symptoms associated with COVID-19, please refrain from attending these events. Entry withdrawals due to illness will be refunded in full.

COVID REFUND POLICY: In the event that provincial regulations change and force the cancellation of these events prior to the day of the event, entry fees will be refunded.

Though we greatly appreciate offers of help, designated club members will be sole handlers of pulleys/tie downs and any other equipment in use at the event.

Eligible Entries

Open to any Afghan, Azawakh, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Whippet, Irish Wolfhound or CKC Miscellaneous Sighthound that is one year or older the day of the trial. All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration, with the Canadian Kennel Club, have ERN # or PEN #. Hounds presently disqualified under CKC, ASFA, CSFA OR AKC rules cannot compete. Hounds with breed standard disqualifications, or altered/neutered are eligible to enter the lure field trial. Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada. See information elsewhere in this Premium List.

Placements and Awards

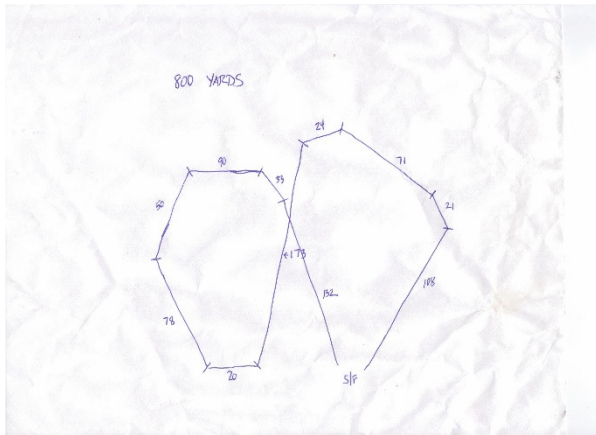
Chapter 7, Section 1: Championship points are awarded in regular stakes only on the following basis:

1st: 4 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 40 points
2nd: 3 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 30 points
3rd: 2 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 20 points
4th: 1 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 10 points
NBQ: No points

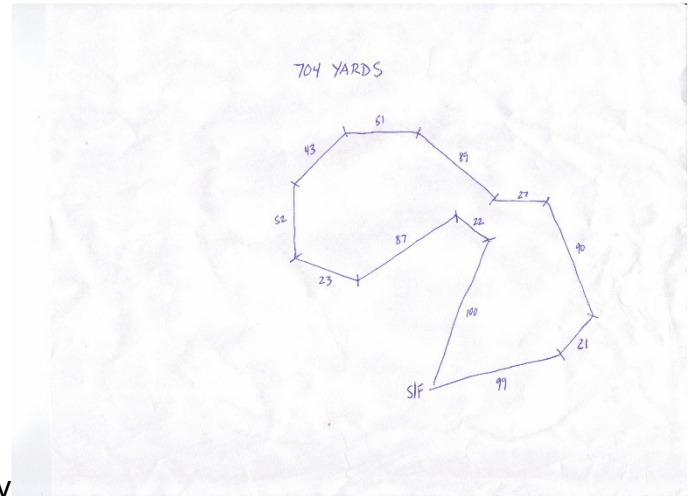
No hound shall receive a placement or points if it does not score at least 50% of the total possible combined scores. If a hound has been excused in the preliminary run, that hound shall not count as having been in competition. Exhibitors please note: As per rule 9.6.1(b) of the CKC Lure Field Trial Rules and Regulations a dog must "Attain 1 first or 2 second placements by defeating dogs in head to head competition". No placements will be awarded towards CKC championships if all dogs in a breed run as singles, but the points will stand.

UNOFFICIAL SINGLES COMPETITION BOTH DAYS LIMITED TO 10 ENTRIES

Rolling Roll Call from when you arrive until 9:30 AM. Your dog is DI or not ready for running in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Dogs will be run individually and scored by both judges. Hounds will run after the open stake has completed its preliminary round and then again after the open stake has completed its final round. Your dog will be only given ONE opportunity to chase the lure each time it comes to the line. Handlers will not be able to run/walk the course with their hounds. A random draw will determine the order of running of dogs in this stake. Dogs must wear a blanket. No points are awarded and all ties are settled by a coin toss. A trophy and ribbon will be awarded to 1st place and ribbons for 2nd to NBQ.

Every dog not registered with the CKC must have a TCN - Temporary Competition Number. TCNs are replacing the current system of entering events with dogs as “listed” and allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). **A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.** Dogs who a need PEN number cannot compete as TCN.

CHEQUES SHOULD BE MADE PAYABLE TO: FOOTHILLS GAZEHOUND CLUB

Please note: there are two waivers that must be signed either at the field or sent with email entries, or your dog will not be allowed to participate. Copies of the waivers will NOT be available at the event. Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques & declined credit cards will be assessed a \$25.00 service charge (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules). To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Event Secretary after the closing time and date. Please allow ample time for delays in the mail. **NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT PAYMENT IN FULL AND NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED VIA EMAIL TO THE EVENT SECRETARY.** Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. Overpayments and duplicate entries will be considered a donation to our trophy fund. Thank you!

- Overnight parking permitted on field. Please park in the designated areas. Email fgc@rimouski.org if you're camping.
- Port-a-potty on site.
- Stakes will be split if the entry is 24 or more hounds at roll call.
- Hounds will be run twice, in braces or trios (except single dog entries) unless excused, dismissed, or declared ineligible.
- Lame hounds or bitches in season will be excused and their entry refunded, provided notice is given prior to or during roll call.
- Hounds not present at roll call shall be scratched with no refunds. No Exceptions.
- All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing a hound. A Standing Start will be used on Tally-Ho.
- Leg wrappings must be of a neutral colour to comply with CKC rules. Muzzles & catch collars may be used at the handler's discretion. **No Flexi-leads, prong or shock collars allowed.**
- A \$10.00 fine will be assessed for loose dogs on the field after roll call and until after Best in Field.
- Bring your own water and shade.
- No catalogue will be published. Score sheets will be available.
- A veterinary clinic is within easy access from the field.
- Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs. Do not stuff plastic bags down holes. Please use the trash receptacles provided.
- Please come early to help fill gopher holes as they have been very busy.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-12-3)

- c) "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members"

If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

This fee does not have to be paid before entering this event.

ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate with certified cheque, money order, VISA or MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$64.00 + 5% GST. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

- To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity; however as of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the United States, all US Citizens age 16 or older must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.
- Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog, unless under the age of three months.

BOTH WAIVERS MUST BE FILLED OUT AND RETURNED WITH ENTRY FORMS FOR YOUR ENTRY TO BE COMPLETE. COPIES OF THE WAIVERS WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE AT THE EVENT.
