She has spent many years training and mentoring under Lynn Leach and is a trainer, teacher and handler of many breeds.

Cost: Working spot - \$450/dog. Auditing: \$50/day/person – Please leave your dogs at home

Only 8 spots available

The clinic will be held on sheep with a CKC regulation sized arena and a round pen that will be utilized to accommodate dogs and handlers of all levels. The clinic includes lunch each day and refreshments throughout the day. If you have special dietary needs, please let us know when registering.

Sheep Thrills Farm has free, on-site camping but no hook ups. Best Western Blairmore is the closest pet-friendly hotel.

There will be NO refunds for cancellations unless the spot can be filled by someone on a wait list. A deposit of \$200 is required to hold a spot, with the remainder due by April 15, 2020. There is no discount for multiple dogs and switching dogs during the clinic is not permitted unless agreed to by the clinic host and clinician, and may incur an additional fee.

There is a STRICT Stoop N Scoop policy. ALL dogs must be on a leash, crated or x-penned at all times when not being instructed.
