NOVICE STAKE

A Novice Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial (with no age limit) that have not placed in an All-Age Stake or received placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country. & regulation, Chapter 10.7.1 «Dogs running in Novice Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur». (CKC Field trial rules 10.5.3)

The Novice Stake is a non-steady stake sanctioned by the CCCQ club, not the CKC. There is no age criteria for handlers or dogs. The stake is to be judged in accordance with the CKC rules for the minor stakes, except for steadiness.

PUPPY STAKE:

«A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged.» (CKC field trial rules & regulations, Chapter 10.2)

LIMIT STAKE:

«A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs that have not placed in an Open All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country» (CKC field trial rules & regulations, Chapter 10.3)

OPEN ALL-AGE STAKE:

«An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least 6 months off age, on the day of trial at which the stake is judge». (CKC Field trial rules & regulation, Chapter 10.4)

AMATEUR ALL-AGE STAKE:

«An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months off age, on the day of trial at which the stake is judge». (CKC Field trial rules & regulation, Chapter 10.5.1) – «Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur». (CKC Field trial rules & regulation, Chapter 10.6.1)

POINTS

Championship Points are awarded for placements in the Open All-Age Stake, provided there are eight (8) or more starters:

1st place – 5 points 2nd place – 3 points 3rd place – 2 points 4th place – 1 point

* Dogs without a CKC individual registration number must apply for an ERN within thirty (30) days of their placement.

ENTRIES, CLOSING and DRAW:

The entries will close on May 20th, 2020 at 8:00 P.M

Entry forms must be completed in full and must be received **accompanied with full payment at the Field Trial Secretary** address prior to the Closing Date.

The Club will be unable to accept, cancel or alter any entry after the closing date and time. The draw will follow immediately after closing at the Field Trial Secretary's residence.

Payment can be made by cheque or money order payable to C.C.C.Q.- Leveur. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.

Entry fees will be refunded only for: a bitch in season, a dog that is injured, ill or dies and entry cancelled prior to closing date.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN):

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed"; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBER (TCN) replaces Listing fee:

****NEW** Temporary Competition Number (TCN)** The current system of entering events with «listed dogs» is being replaced with TCNs, and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN), which will be required to enter all events with closing dates after March 2, 2020.

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until it is permanently registered with either a CKC number or an ERN. The TCN fee is \$12.00 per trial (i.e. per dog, per day).

To obtain a TCN:

First check the dog's profile on CKC to determine if CKC has already created a TCN for it.

If not:

- 1) Go to the CKC web site, click on forms, under Shows and Trials click Exhibitors. Find the Temporary-Competition-Number-Application Form. Complete the application form on line and the TCN should be issued instantly.

- 2) You may print the application form and submit it to CKC via mail.
or:
- 3) You may contact Shows and Trials Division by telephone (1-855-364-7252) toll free or email information@ckc.ca.

There is no fee to obtain a TCN, however Exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number. The current TCN fee is \$11.50CDN per trial. (ie. per dog per day)

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE:

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

INDIGNITIES:

«It shall be the duty and obligation of a trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.» (*CKC field trial rules & regulations, 21.7*)

**CCCQ – ST-ANNE-DE-LA-PÉRADE FIELD TRIAL GROUND EVALUATION
VS HAZARDOUS SEEDS / PLANTS**

Following an audit with an agronomist from the «*Ordre des agronomes du Québec*». - There is confirmation that it seems impossible to be able to identify the presence of those types of hazardous plants in Quebec during this spring period and this before the holding of our field trial in late May.

A visual inspection / survey by a specialized agronomist will be carried out during the August / September period, before our fall field trial.

RISK

Since the field trial ground of St-Anne-de-la-Pérade is not in a humid / wetlands environment and is not in the hardiness zone of Quebec favorable to hazardous seeds / plants. The Field Trial community therefore considers the **absence of listed plant species**.

Because according to any risk assessment and management process. The zero-risk «0» option (theoretical and technical) does not exist. The Field Trial community therefore considers (according to a risk matrix) that **the possible exposure risk is very low** (*very low risk*).

NOTICE

- The Club de Chiens de Chasse de Québec and Quebec's Provincial laws **REQUIRE THAT ALL THOSE IN THE FIELD WEAR A BLAZE ORANGE VEST** (*CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations Chap. 17 Sec. 1*). - This will be strictly enforced by the Field Marshall and the Blaze Orange Police (BOP)!
- **No unauthorized ATV (sport motorize vehicles) are permitted to circulate on trial course/ground except CCCQ's ATV.**
- **Chukars** (live full winged gamebirds) will be used for Open and Amateur All-Age Stakes.
- **Chukars or pigeons or both** (live full winged gamebirds) will be used for Limit Stake.
- **There will be no water tests.**
- Official CKC ribbons will be awarded for placements in each Stake following the events on each day's. Keeper plaques and annual trophy will be handed to the winner of each Stake.
- As a member of CNSFTA, CCCQ placements will count towards entry in The Canadian National.
- **Lunch service** will be available each day at the field trial site for a nominal fee.
- The consumption of **alcoholic beverages** in the field and on the property is strictly prohibited.
- The Club de Chiens de Chasse de Québec is a member of the Canadian National Spaniel Field Trial Association. All dogs earning points in this trial are eligible to enter the Canadian National Open Championship for the next two years.
